## Things you need to know

Arrival may begin on Thursday, Sept. 14, 2017 between 9:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. It is preferred that teams must be in their assigned spot by 10:00 am on Friday, September 15. Arrangements should be made in advance for arrivals AFTER 10:00 a.m. Departures may begin after the awards ceremony is completed and must be done by Sunday, Sept. 17, 2017 at 12:00 noon.

Application submittal does not guarantee acceptance to the contest. All spaces will be assigned in the order that application and fees are received. Entry fee must accompany the entry form. Application and fees must be received before August 25, 2017. After August 25, cash/certified check or money order only. Entry fees are non-refundable once you are assigned a space.

Professional Division must cook in all four categories to win Grand Champion or Reserve Champion.

Cook sites are 20 ft. wide x 40 ft. deep. Bring at least 100' of extension cord and water hose. You may need an adaptor, so please come prepared.

FBA meat inspections will be Friday, Sept. 15 between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

A mandatory cooks meeting will be held Friday, Sept. 15 at 5:00 p.m. in the Reception Hall.

Pets allowed in cook teams sites only

Each cook team shall provide, at a minimum, a 5 pound fire extinguisher.

Water and electrical (20 amp) service will be provided to each space. There are a limited number of 50 amp plugs at an additional charge of \$50. These are available on a first come, first paid basis. This must be noted on application.

Beer will be available on the grounds at a reasonable price. All beverages must be consumed from a plastic cup.
